Established in 1967 as a Regional Engineering College in Assam, the National Institute of Technology Silchar, is one of the 31 national institutes of technology in India. Six engineering degree-offering branches and five non-engineering branches comprise the institution. The NIRF Rankings 2023 rank NIT Silchar 40th in engineering and 83rd overall. The QS Asia University Ranking 2023 places NIT Silchar in the rank band 401-450. NIT Silchar is ranked in rank band 601-800 in The World University Rankings 2023. NIT Silchar has been ranked in the rank band 501-600 for engineering in the The World University Ranking 2023.
